YOUR IMPACT IN 2024



ABARA HOUSE

- Over 70% of the first \$2 million for Phase 1 has been funded to secure the historic site
- Secured a \$50,000 matching gift to purchase Historic Ft. Bliss Barracks
- Hosted myriad of events involving thousands of voices



BORDER ENCOUNTERS

- 321 leaders representing 25 states
- 100% feel better equipped to contextualize current border realities
- 97% better understand root causes of forced displacement



BORDER RESPONSE

- Facilitated provision of food, groceries, legal support, and employment aid
- Supported 25 shelters with resources
- Served 17,361 forcibly displaced neighbors and leaders from 14 different shelters
